

Natalizumab – the basics

- A monoclonal antibody against CAM α4-integrin.
 - Prevents inflamatory cell migration across the BBB and from GI absorption
 - USES: MS and Crohns
 - Efficacy: ↓Relaspse in MS symptoms by 68% compared to placebo
 - Administration: IV every 28 days

Natalizumab – Indications / Contraindications

- Indicated as a MONOtherapy for MS
 - As opposed to combination therapy with interferon beta-1a (IB1A)
 - SI: PML (approved by FDA in 2004, quickly removed, then returned in 2006.
 - PML often fatal, caused by JC Virus
