## **Optic Neuritis**

- Inflammation of the optic disk
- r/o Demyelinating Myelopathies (MS, NMO)
- DD:
  - Parameningeal/ meningeal/ intraocular inflammation assoc. w/ viral infections
  - Toxins (e.g. methanol, ethambutol)
  - Neurosyphilis
  - Vit. B12 Def.

# Optic Neuritis – Cont.

### • S/S:

- Unilateral impairment of visual acuity
- Time span: hrs -> days. Max. w/in 1 week
- Headache, globe tenderness, eye pain

### • Diagnosis:

- Central scotoma on visual field test
- Decreased visual acuity
- Fundus: unilateral disk swelling
- Pupils: equal but reduced reaction to illumination

# Optic Neuritis – cont.

- In demyelinating disease acuity usually improves over 2-3 weeks.
- Tx:
  - IV methylprednisolone 1 g/d for 3 days
  - PO prednisone 1 mg/kg/d for 11 days
- Prognosis:
  - Progression to MS w/in 15 yrs (74% ♀, 34%♂)

### **NMO**

- Once considered a variant of MS
- Assoc. w/ specific antibody: NMO-IgG which targets water channel Aquaporin-4
- S/S:
  - Optic Neuritis
  - Acute Myelitis: spastic weakness, paralysis, loss of sensation, autonomic dysfunction

#### MRI:

- Extends over at least 3 spinal segments
- No widespread involvement of white matter

### NMO – Cont.

- Tx:
  - Long term immunosuppression Azathioprine
  - IV corticosteroids
  - Plasmapharesis
  - Rituximab
- Prognosis:
  - No Cure relapsing disorder
